THE FENIAN PROCLAMATION

The Irish People to the World

We have suffered centuries of outrage, enforced poverty, and bitter misery. Our rights and liberties have been trampled on by an alien aristocracy, who treating us as foes, usurped our lands, and drew away from our unfortunate country all material riches.

The real owners of the soil were removed to make room for cattle, and driven across the ocean to seek the means of living, and the political rights denied to them at home, while our men of thought and action were condemned to loss of life and liberty. But we never lost the memory and hope of a national existence. We appealed in vain to the reason and sense of justice of the dominant powers. Our mildest remonstrance's were met with sneers and contempt. Our appeals to arms were always unsuccessful.

Today, having no honourable alternative left, we again appeal to force as our last resource. We accept the conditions of appeal, manfully deeming it better to die in the struggle for freedom than to continue an existence of utter serfdom.

All men are born with equal rights, and in associating to protect one another and share public burdens, justice demands that such associations should rest upon a basis which maintains equality instead of destroying it.

We therefore declare that, unable longer to endure the curse of

Monarchical Government, we aim at founding a Republic based on universal suffrage, which shall secure to all the intrinsic value of their labour.

The soil of Ireland, at present in the possession of an oligarchy, belongs to us, the Irish people, and to us it must be restored. We declare, also, in favour of absolute liberty of conscience, and complete separation of Church and State.

We appeal to the Highest Tribunal for evidence of the justness of our cause. History bears testimony to the integrity of our sufferings, and we declare, in the face of our brethren, that we intend no war against the people of England – our war is against the aristocratic locusts, whether English or Irish, who have eaten the verdure of our fields – against the aristocratic leeches who drain alike our fields and theirs. Republicans of the entire world, our cause is your cause. Our enemy is your enemy. Let your hearts be with us. As for you, workmen of England, it is not only your hearts we wish, but your arms. Remember the starvation and degradation brought to your firesides by the oppression of labour. Remember the past, look well to the future, and avenge yourselves by giving liberty to your children in the coming struggle for human liberty.

Herewith we proclaim the Irish Republic.

THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT

This proclamation was issued in March 1867 by the Provisional Government of the Irish Republic which had been established by the Irish Republican Brotherhood on the 10th February that year.

8-15 DEIREADH FÓMHAIR

Agus muid ag pleanáil Fhéile na Carraige 2017, tá Gaeil Uachtar Chluanaí ag machnamh ar bhliain d'fhás leanúnach, d'fhorbairt agus de ghnímh, ach bliain inar buaileadh muid le neart constaicí agus dúshlán chomh maith. Gríosaíodh agus rinneadh polaitíú ar ghlúin úr de Ghaeil radacacha i Márta na bliana seo nuair a baineadh ár maoiniú óige. Mar thoradh air sin, d'eagraigh na daoine óga sin cruinní plódaithe pobail mar aon le hagódí suí isteach ag oifig an Údarás Oideachais.

Spreag an agóid úd athrú intinne ó lucht na cumhactha agus tugadh ar ais agus cuireadh leis an mhaoiniú i ndiaidh cúpla seachtain. Léirigh sin go dtig le gnáthdhaoine rudaí a athrú le leas an phobail agus go gcothaíonn gníomh frithbheartaíochta muinín agus polaitíocht an dócháis.

Tugann an feachtas sin léiriú beacht ar Ghlór na Móna agus cuireann sé in iúl cad é dó a seasann Féile na Carraige. Dúinn, is ionann an saol pearsanta agus polaitíúil agus a mhalaírt. Tá muid den bharúil go dtosáíonn sé seo inár bpobal le hathghhabháil na Gaeilge. Mar eagraíocht agus mar phobal, tá muid ar maos sa traidisiún phoblachtánach le leas an phobail atá le sonrú go foirfe i bhforógra radacach na bhFíníni agus déanfar comóradh 150 bliain ar Éirí Amach na bhFíníni 1868 ag imeacht blantúil de scéalta's d'amhráin in ómós Harry Holland.

Cé acu oidhreacht fhorásach réabhlóideach Ernesto 'Che' Guevara, a dúnmharaíodh go díreach 50 bliain ó shin i mí Dheireadh Fómhair; streachált na mbán san am mar a bhí agus mar atá; an cath neamhchríochnaithe ar son an díchoilínithe, streachált an lucht oibre i gcoinne an ocras agus an chrucháis sna 1930í nó na tuméactaí ceannródaíocha teanga a bhain címí poblachtánacha amach i nGaeilge na FuiSEOige sa Cheis Fhada sna 1990í, agus tá mana ár bhféile, Párteachas, Polaitíocht agus Pobal i gcroílár na rudaí sin luate.

Tugann ár dtiomantas leanúnach, a théann i gngleic le gníomhchleachtas athmhachnamhach agus le hathnuachan, an spreagadh dúinn tográí úra a bhunú ar nós Suí's Scíth atá diríthe ar thuistí atá ag tógáil a gclainne trí Ghaeilge sa bhaile, gan trácht ar an fhreastal ar mhiantáí ár ndaoine óga chun a saol a chaitheamh trí Ghaeilge leis an dlúthbhaint atá againn le bunú Ógchumann Laochra Loch Lao.

Cuirfear sea ar fad os comhair an phobail i seachtain cheiliúrtha na Féile. Tá sé de rún ag Féile na Carraige dúshlán agus misneach a thabhairt chomh maith leis an líon is mó daoine áitiúla a mhealladh a chothóidh cultúr dearfach de dhlúthpháirtíocht agus de chomhoibriú daonna, mar aon le seachtain shultmhar de chraic a chur ar fáil.

Tá Féile na Carraige fite fuaite sa phobal áitiúil a thugann ardán do ghníomhaithe níos óige agus na tográí pobail nuálacha a d'fhorbair go horgánach ó ghluaiseacht teanga atá tiomanta ar son athrú sóisialta.

Ar deireadh thiar thall, is ar mhaithe le tógáil na poblachta san áit a seasann muid, ag tosú i gcónai lenár ndualgas go háitiúil agus go dúchasach, atá san Fhéile seo agus san obair a dhéanann muid.

Tugann muid cuireadh duit bheith páirteach san Fhéile agus cuidiú linn an aidhm fhiúntach sin a bhaint amach.

8-15 OCTOBER

When planning Féile na Carraige 2017, Upper Springfield Gaels reflected on a year of sustained growth, development and action that threw many challenges and curveballs our way. The removal of our youth funding in March galvanised and politicised a new generation of radical young Gaels who organised a packed public meeting and subsequent sit-in protest in the Education Authority offices.

This prompted a swift change of heart from those in power and saw the funding restored and increased within weeks. This proved that ordinary people can change things for the better and that successful acts of resistance breed confidence and the politics of hope.

This campaign summed up Glór na Móna and encapsulates what Féile na Carraige stands for. For us the personal is political and the political is personal and this starts in our community with the re-conquest of the Irish language. As an organisation and as a community, we are steeped in the republican tradition of civic virtue which is captured perfectly in the radical Fenian proclamation of 1868, which will be accounted for in our Annual Harry Holland song and story event exactly 150 years since the Fenian uprising.

Whether is the progressive revolutionary legacy of Ernesto 'Che' Guevara, murdered 50 years this October; the women's struggle past and present; the unfinished battle for decolonisation; the working-class struggle against economic hardship in the hungry thirties or the miraculous language immersion accomplishments of republican prisoners in Long Kesh's Gaeltacht na FuiSEOige in 1990's, our Féile motto, of politics, participation and community is always at their core.

Our ongoing commitment to engaging in reflective praxis and renewal inspires new initiatives such as our Suí & Scíth mothers and toddlers group aimed specifically at those raising their children through Irish at home language, whilst our central involvement in ógchumann CLG Laochra Loch Lao serves as another transformative extension of our desire to fulfil our young people's needs to live their lives through Irish.

All this and more will be showcased and celebrated over the week. While our Féile intends to challenge, inspire and involve as many people as possible in a way that normalises a can-do culture of solidarity and collaboration, it also seeks to entertain and foster a sense of enjoyment and craic.

Féile na Carraige is embedded in our local area and gives a platform to younger activists and transformative new community projects that have developed organically from a langauge movement committed to social change.

Our Féile and our work is ultimately about building the republic 'where we stand' and starting always with our duty to our local and native place.

We invite you to take part in our Féile and help us fulfill this worthy aim.

Máirtín Ó Maolmhuaidh

Máirtín is from Strabane, Co Tyrone and was imprisoned in the H-Blocks of Long Kesh from 1976 to 1984 where he learned Irish. He was re-arrested and imprisoned in the H-blocks from 1988 to 1998, playing a pivotal role in the setting up of the Irish-speaking wing in the prison, Gaealtacht na Faiseoige, in 1995. He involved himself in Irish language activism on his release and was instrumental in pioneering Irish medium provision in Strabane. He spent a period working for Comhairle na Gaelscolaíochta, ten years as a development officer for Gaelphobal an tSráth Bán and now works as a freelance translator.

Jamesy Ó Muireagáin

Jamesy is from Belfast and was imprisoned in the H-Blocks of Long Kesh from 1991 to 1998. He learned his Irish on the Gaeltacht wing and successfully completed his GCSE and A'Level Irish while imprisoned. Upon his release he re-involved himself in Irish language and community activism and taught Irish a number of different accredited BIFHE courses. He now works full-time in Coláiste Feirste as school caretaker.

Seán Ó Daimhín

Seán is from Strabane and spent periods imprisoned in Crumlin Road Jail and Long Kesh prison. He learned and taught Irish in prison and became central to the concept of Gaealtacht na Faiseoige in the late 1990's. Upon his release from prison, he has been heavily involved in the Irish language revival movement. He is a founding member of locally based Irish language community organisation Gaelphobal an tSráth Bán in Strabane. He still lives in Strabane but currently works as Irish language officer for Donegal county council and is based Lifford.


