





1 - 7 Deireadh Fómhair

Cuirimid Féile na Carraige 2018 i bhur láthair agus Pobal Ghlór na Móna i mbun ceiliúrtha ar bhlain stairiúil seo na Gaeilge agus aitheantas bainte amach mar an grúpa Gaeilge is rathúla sa tír le príomhdhuais náisiúnta Ghlór na nGael don bhlain 2017 inár seilbh. D'aithin na moltóirí go bhfuil rud éigin speisialta agus as an choitiantacht fán dream óg de Ghaeil chumasacha, ghairmiúla agus oilte atá ag tiomáint na hathbheochana Gaelaf I gceantar an Uachtair Chluanaí.

Tá fír spreagúil na ndaoine óga seo le mothú sa chlár cumhachtach seo a thugann tú sí áite do bhun-éiteas na Féile: Páirteachas, Polaitiocht agus Pobal. Tá sé d'aidhm ag na himeachtaí agus tionscadail atá cuimsithe san fhéile spásanna a chruthú a chothaíonn saoirse intinne agus anama i measc an phobail. Tuigimid nach féidir seo a dhéanamh gan fealsúnacht radacach, ionraic a éascú a ithníonn nach féidir linn pobail a chumhachtú gan an córas suarach atá anuas orainn a athrú agus féidearthachtaí fuascailteacha a shamhlú chun oibriú ina dtreo.

Feictear an dinimic seo go soiléir sna téamaí cuimhneacháin agus athmhachnaimh atá fite fuaite sa chlár agus a cheiliúrann agus a chíorann gluaiseachtaí forásacha agus iarrachtaí misniúla chun domhan níos fearr a shamhlú.

Ina measc siúd, tugtar suntas ar leith do Ghluaiseachta na gCeart Sibhialta sna 1960óidí, agus muid ag comóradh 50 bliain ó sheas glúin úr an fód in aghaidh leatrom agus bhrúidiúlacht an stáit oráistigh. Is amhlaigh atá le comóradh 30 bliain ar Féile an Phobail nuair a d'imir cosmhuintir an Uachtair Chluanaí ról ceannasach sa phléascadh tallainne is cruthaithí a bhréagnaigh dioscúrsa Stáit na Breataine a mhaslaigh muid mar 'bharbarraigh agus pobal sceimhlitheoireachta'. Is ón tobar agus mograla féinchuidithe céanna a d'fhorbair Bunscoil an tSléibhe Dhuibh 25 bliain ó shin agus beidh imeacht speisialta eile san Fhéile a thugann aitheantas do na Fathaigh sin a leag dúshraith agus oidhreacht chlaochlaineach a chothaigh fuinneamh sna glúnta a tháinig ina ndiaidh.

Is le súil ghéar ar an todhchaí agus an chéad ghlúin eile go n-oscláinn muid comhrá fosta i measc an aosa óig fá Éire Aontaithe agus Neamhspleách i dtréimhse chorraiteach seo na Breataimeachta. Tá seo tráthúil dúinn mar Ghaeil mar gur imir feachtas cumhachtach s'agáinn sa Dream Dearg ról lárnach ag glacadh córas rialtais ó thuaidh go talamh agus ceist na teanga aitheantaanois mar scrúdú litmus d'aon socrú polaitiúil úr ó thuaidh. Le gach cuma ar an scéal go bhfuil dígeantacht an aontachtachais pholaitiúla ag léiriú don domhan mór go bhfuil an stat ó thuaidh do-leasuithe agus do-oibrithe, mothaímid gur am feiliúnach é don Fhéile chun comhrá níos leithne a oscailt a shamhláionn an cineál córais agus sochaí atá muid i dteideal mar Ghaeil agus Shaoránaigh.

Ach lena chois seo agus sa mhullach ar an diospóireacht, athmhachnamh, cóir agus cúiteamh, tá sult agus spraoi lárnach san fhéile le ceol, drámaíocht, is spóirt mar dhlúthchuid don tseachtaíimeachtaí. Mar a dúirt an gníomhaire iomráiteach, ainrialach agus feimineach Emma Goldman, "If I can't dance I don't want to be part of your revolution", is ní sheanódh muid an ceart sin oraibh agus Gig na Carraige ag tabhairt ardán do cheoltóirí áitiúil Jake Mac, album úr ag na ceoltóirí traidisiúnta iomráiteacha, Barry is Laura Kerr agus ag críochnú leis an sárghrúpa KILA chun spiorad na féile a mhúscailt ionainn!

In presenting Féile na Carraige 2018, the Glór na Móna community celebrate an historic year when we were recognised as the most successful Irish language group in the country by winning the prestigious Glór na nGael national prize to add to our Aisling award. The judges recognised that there was something unique and special about this cohort of committed, professional and energetic young Gaels who are driving the Irish language revival in the Upper Springfield area.

The inspirational vision being developed by this new generation of activists is visible in this powerful programme of events which prioritises the primary aims of the Féile: Participation, Politics and Community. Thus, the events and projects being showcased during the Féile aim to create space and encourage people to think critically and take control of their own destiny.

In our view, this requires a radical approach and philosophy that recognises that we can't empower communities without also seeking to transform the current, unjust economic and political system through working towards and imagining emancipatory opportunities to bring that change about.

This same dynamic is clear in the themes of commemoration and reflection that is central to this years' programme which celebrates and unpacks some of the progressive movements and courageous grassroots efforts to build a better world.

Amongst these, we pay special attention to the Civil Rights movement of the 1960's as we reflect 50 years on since a new generation stood up against the brutality and endemic discrimination of the Orange State. Similarly, we recall Féile an Phobail on its 30th anniversary and those local activists from the Upper Springfield area who played a leading role in fostering the tremendous explosion of talent and creativity that contradicted the self-serving British state and media discourse which described us as a 'barbaric, terrorist community'. It is from this same self-help network that our Ballymurphy Gaelscoil, Bunscoil an tSléibhe Dhuibh was established 25 years ago and we will be hosting a special event that recognises the giants who led those foundations and left a transformational legacy for the generations who have passed through their doors and the activists who followed in their footsteps.

It's with a sharp focus on the future and the next generation that we open a conversation amongst our young people about the possibilities of a free and independent Ireland in this era of Brexit. This is fitting for us as Gaels, in that the powerful, community-led Dream Dearg campaign played a central role in toppling the Stormont power sharing executive with the language question now viewed as a litmus test for any future attempts to arrive at a political solution in the north. With the increasingly intransigent attitude of political unionism to the question of rights for all, more and more are coming to the conclusion that the northern state is unworkable and irreformable. We therefore feel, that there has been no better time to open a wider discussion that both imagines and debates what kind of political system or new society is befitting of Ireland and its citizens.

In addition to the debate, reflection and heated discussion, we always ensure that light-hearted fun and entertainment are also central to the Féile with top quality music, drama and sports integral to the week-long programme, combining the best of national and local talent. As the eminent anarchist and feminist activist Emma Goldman famously stated, "If I can't dance I don't want to be part of your revolution" and we would not deny you that right. This is best exemplified by Gig na Carraige which presents local singer-songwriter Jake Mac, the brilliant new album from renowned traditional musicians Barry and Laura Kerr before being headlined by the great KILA who will no doubt awaken the spirit of the Féile in us! So seize the opportunity and take part in the revolution!
