"Come, then, comrades, the European game has finally ended; we must find something different. We today can do everything, so long as we do not imitate Europe, so long as we are not obsessed by the desire to catch up with Europe. Europe now lives at such a mad, reckless pace that she has shaken off all guidance and all reason, and she is running headlong into the abyss; we would do well to avoid it with all possible speed. The Third World today faces Europe like a colossal mass whose aim should be to try to resolve the problems to which Europe has not been able to find the answers. But let us be clear: what matters is to stop talking about output, and intensification, and the rhythm of work. No, we do not want to catch up with anyone. Foreword

Le duilleoga dathúla ar chasadadh agus fuacht fionnuar san aer, tá teacht ní hamháin ar an Fhómhar, ach ar Fhéile na Carraige chomh maith agus clár spreagúil agus spleodrach do 2023 ina bhfuil ár mana Páirteachas, Polaitiocht, Pobal sáite in achan imeach! Is bliain eile é 2023 d'fhás agus forbairt i nGór na Móna agus pobal na Gaeilge i gcoitinne agus déanann muid ceiliúradh ar an ghníomhú agus na héacátaí a baineadh amach ar na mallaibh agus tugann muid aitheantas do na cora cinniúnacha sa stair i mbliana fost. Bhain an feachtas pobalbhunaithe ó Bhaile Uí Mhurchú, Donate4Dáithí, Dlí Dáithí amach ag túis na bliana – comhghairdeas mó� lenár ndlúthchairde Seph, Máirtín agus Dáithí. Tchífidh sibh na dathanna Glas, Dubh, Dearg agus Bán fite fuaite san Fhéile i mbliana i ndlúthpháirtíocht leis an Phalaistín agus mar cheiliúradh ar an nasc úr idir Glór na Móna agus an tlonad Lajee i gCampa Aida, sciafite misniúil atá ag déanamh sárobair ar son na cosmhuintire ansin in éadan an choilíneachais.

Rachaidh airgead bailithe ag an Oíche Phalaistíne, ar an tSatharn 14ú Deireadh Fómhair i dtreo an ionaid agus an giom pobail ACLAÍ Palestine atá ag tabhairt dóchas do phobal faoi léigear. Ceiliúrann Conradh na Gaeilge 130 bliain ar an fhód i mbliana agus léirigh ráiteas Dhubhghlas De híde, bunaitheoir an Chonartha, fá 'dhíghalldú na hÉireann' an géarghá leis an díchoilíniú atá fós le baint amach in Éirinn.

Tá ceist an choilíneachais in Éirinn go mór i mbéal an phobail faoi láthair. Tá an uasaicme pholaitiúil agus na meáin nuactha ó thuaidh agus ó dheas ar buile tar éis na milte duine óga a chluinstin ag canadh amhráin phoblachtánacha ag Féile an Phobail agus Electric Picnic leis na grúpaí Kneecap agus The Wolfe Tones. Ní hé móradh an fhoréigin a chuireann isteach orthu i ndáiríre, ach an rud is measa ná go léiríonn seo go bhfuil tóir ag daoine óga na hÉireann ar an poblachtánachas agus stair fhuasailteach na nGael. Is cinnte go mbeidh na teachtaireachtáí agus éiteas díchoilíniúthe céanna ar taispeáint ag Gig na Féile s'agáinn – chomh maith le hóiche lán de chraic agus

spraoi – leis na grúpaí úra Gaeilge Na Shan Vans agus Torby, Niamh Nic Ionnraeachtaigh agus na ceoltóirí cumhachtacha Seán-Nóis as Ard Mhacha Theas, Bláithín Mhic Cana agus Piarás Ó Lorcáin a bheas uilig ar an ardán an Satharn 21ú Deireadh Fómhair i nGort na Móna CLG.

Cruthaíonn Féile na Carraige spásanna orgánacha cruthaitheacha do mhuintir an phobail teacht le chéile chun smaoineamh faoi na bealaí chun muid féin a eagrú agus tréimhsí fuascailte na staire a athmhúnú ins an lá atá inniu ann. Chuige sin, beidh ceardlann ar mhálartú teanga – Gaeilge agus Araibis – ar siúl ar an Luan 16ú chun cúpla focal agus stair na dteangacha a fhoghlaím. Tá lúcháir orainn ár ndlúthpháirtíocht leis an fheachtas ón bhun aníos ‘Flip the Script’ a neartú arís i mbliana le comhrá idir ár gcairde Siobhán McCallin agus Sara Boyce ar an chnuasach dán nua Shiobhán ‘Awakening M.E.’ ar an Luan 16ú agus beidh comhrá spreagúil leis an tSíciatrá Chriticíúl iomráiteach, an Dr Pat Bracken, a labhróidh faoin ghéarghá le cur chuige nua daonna maidir leis an tsláinte mheabhrach ar an Chéadaoin 18ú in ionad Naomh Comhghall.

Tá an Ghaeilge i lár an aonaigh i mBéal Feirste arís maidir le comharthaí dátheangacha a bheas ag dul in airde i Sólann Olympia, ceantar comhroinnt, tar éis feachtas An Dream Dearg, feachtas rathúil díchoilíniithe a bhfuil breis is 20,000 duine mar bhall de, Gaeilgeoirí óga spreagúla den chuid is mó. Saol trí Ghaeilge atá uainn agus cuirfear seo chun cinn san Fhéile le himeachtaí éagsúla: léacht ar athbheochan na Gaeilge sa tréimhse chorraitheach staire idir 1981-91 leis an Chraoltóir Raidió Cháiliúil Eoghan Ó Néill; Slí na Sí an Fómhair le Gráinne Holland, plé-phainéal an-tráthúil de chuid Fís an Phobail ar ‘Pleanáil Teanga in Éirinn – Foinse dóchais nó dallamullóg?'; Dianchúrsa na Gaeilge; tráth na gceist na mbunscoileanna i gColáiste Feirste; agus lá spóirt ‘s spraoi leis an chumann CLG díchoilíniithe Laochra Loch Lao.

Lena chois sin, tá áthas an domhain orainn a fhógaírt go mbeidh an Teachta Dála Eoin Ó Broin linn do Léacht Harry Holland agus é ag cíordadh fis s'aige do Chlár Claochaitheach Títhíochta in Éirinn úr ar an Déardaoin 19ú Deireadh Fómhair i nGael-Ionad Mhic Goill. Tá mórcheisteanna na Féile i mbliana ag díriú ar na dushláin agus féidearthachtaí atá os ár gcomhair mar phobal maidir le hathghiniúint teanga, Éire Aontaithe agus neodracht na tíre, ceartas eacnamaíochta trí thithíochta do chách agus cur chuige úr daonna maidir le Sláinte Mheadhrach agus ceisteanna breise nach iad. Le seachtainí beaga anuas, cailleadh gníomhaithe pobail agus diograiseoirí teanga misniúla ar nós Matt Lundy agus Rónán Mac Aodha Bhúi a thaispeáin dúinn gur gá dúinn troid ar son na Poblachta úire atá uainn. Feictear dúinn go bhfuil dualgas agus freaghracht ar leith ag an ghlúin seo de dhíograiseoirí chun sochaí níos fearr a shamhlú agus a thógáil. Mar a dúirt an Fealsúnaí agus Gníomhá Díchoilíniithe, Frantz Fanon: ‘Every generation must, out of relative obscurity, discover its mission, fulfill it or betray it.’ Go n-éirí linn!

Foreword

As the leaves change colour and the crisp nip returns to the air, both autumn and Féile na Carraige return in unison to greet us with another inspirational and exciting programme for 2023 under the maxim of Politics, Participation and Community. This has been another year of growth and renewal for Glór na Móna and the wider Irish language community as we celebrate activism and achievements that have changed the course of recent history. The community based campaign, Donate4Daithí, emanating from the Ballymurphy area, has ensured the victorious passage of Daithí's Law earlier this year and we send our congratulations to our esteemed friends, Seph, Máirtín and Daithí.

The colours of Green, Black, Red and White are noteworthy in this year's programme as an act of solidarity with the oppressed people of Palestine and also as a celebration of the connections between Glór na Móna and the Lajee Centre in the Aida Camp. This courageous and pioneering community

regeneration project does amazing work for those brave communities who struggle against Colonialism and Apartheid. Funds raised from our Palestine Solidarity night on Saturday 14th October will support the centre and the groundbreaking community gym, ACLAÍ Palestine which gives hope to those suffering under Israeli occupation. We also celebrate 130 years of Conradh na Gaeilge and the famous statement of its founder Dubhghlas de hÍde, regarding the need to 'De-Anglicise' Ireland, and its continuing relevance to the Ireland's unfinished project of Decolonisation

The question of Colonialism is in vogue again as a topic of discussion and debate amongst our people. Political elites and mainstream media outlets, north and south, are angry and frightened that thousands of young people are singing republican ballads at Féile and Phobail and Electric Picnic with acts such as Kneecap and the Wolfe Tones. It isn't the glorification of violence they fear but rather the threat of young people in Ireland listening to alternative views on republicanism and the liberatory reading on the history of Ireland.

These same sentiments and this decolonising ethos will be on stage at the Féile Gig- along with entertainment and craic- with new and emerging bands, The Shan Vans, the Rapper 'Torby', Niamh Nic Ionnraichte and the powerful Séan-Nós singers from South Armagh, Bláithín Mhic Canna and Piaras Ó Lorcáin who will also take to the stage at Gort na Móna CLG on 21 October.

Féile na Carraige creates organic and creative spaces for the community to come together and think critically about how we can self-organise and recalibrate emancipatory periods in Irish history and make them relevant for the present day. To this end, there will be a workshop on language exchange- between Irish and Arabic- on Monday the 16th October where 'cupla focal' and comparative linguistic histories will be shared. We are delighted to support the bottom-up community campaign 'A New Script' for mental health by showcasing our very own Siobhán McCallin's new poetry anthology 'Awakening ME' when she will be in conversation with Sara Boyce on her writing and activism. In addition, we are very grateful that the renowned Critical Psychiatrist Dr Pat Bracken has agreed to travel from West Cork to share his inspiring philosophy and help us envision a more humane approach to Mental Health on Wednesday 18th October in St Comhghalls at lunchtime.

The Irish language continues to shape the media debate as Bilingual signage at shared community spaces like Olympia Leisure Centre gather momentum on the heels of the successful Dream Dearg campaign where over 20,000 young Gaels marched for equality and justice. Young Gaels demand the right to live their lives through Irish and this theme emerges again in this year's programme; radio presenter Eoghán Ó Néill will deliver a lecture on his upcoming book about the language movement during the tumultuous period between 1981-91; local traditional singer and artist Gráinne Holland

brings us the Autumn Slí na Sí; West Belfast Language plan Fís an Phobail are organising a topical national discussion on 'Language planning in Ireland- as source of hope or delusion'; our annual Féile na Carraige Irish language crash course for learners; a quiz for Bunscoil Children in Coláiste Feirste and the GAA blitz and fun day with our GAA club CLG Laochra Loch Lao.

We are also thrilled that Eoin Ó Broin TD will deliver our annual Harry Holland lecture where we will discuss his vision for a 'Transformative housing agenda in a new Ireland on Thursday 19th October in Gaelionad Mhic Goill. This year's festival themes focus our attention on the topical challenges and opportunities that we face such as; Language Revitalisation, a United Ireland and Irish Neutrality; socio-economic rights and the need for adequate housing for all and the urgent requirement for a more humane approach to mental health. In recent weeks, we have lost community activists and language revitalisation stalwarts such as the great Matt Lundy and Rónán Mac an Bhúi who remind us of the need to rededicate ourselves to the cause of building a new republic. In our view, this generation has a duty and responsibility to both imagine and build a radical, new society. As the renowned decolonisation activist and philosopher Frantz Fanon summarized: : 'Every generation must, out of relative obscurity, discover its mission, fulfill it or betray it.' Go n-éirí linn!






