Ainmnithe ina dhiaidh an Gaeilgeoir agus poblachtánoch sóisialach radacach, Máirtín Ó Cadhain, don 2ú bliain i ndiaidh a chéile eagraíodh Scoil Gheimhridh Uí Chadhain. Is é an aidhm atá againn ná chun ardán daonlathach agus ionchuimsitheach a chuir ar fáil do ghniomhaithe ó réimse d’fheachtais an phobail ar mhaith le hÉire úr bunaithe ar na focail faire ‘Fuascailt, Comhionannas agus Dlíúpháirtíocht’.

Tá an comhrá maidir le hÉire Aontaithe ag bailiú nirt diaidh ar ndiaidh. Tá sciarannna leathan den phobal anois páirteach sa diospóireacht fud fad an tsochaí maidir le todhchaí bunreachtúil na tíre agus beidh brú de dhíth le cinniú go bhfuil miantáig agus aisling na pobail ar an iméall lárnoch sa chomhrá níos leithne sin.

Tá lúcháir an domhain orainn go mbeidh Clare Daly MEP, Bríd Smith TD agus Chris Hazzard MP linn ar an phríomhphainéil Dé Sathairn 27ú Eanáir faoin teideal ‘Ag Tógáil Éire Nua ach ar son cén aicme?’ chomh maith le haoichtainteoir na scoile, Mansoor Adayfi i gcomhrá le Clare Daly maidir leis an fheachtas ‘Druid Guantanamo Bay’. B’iospartach céastóireachta é Mansoor ar feadh 14 bliain faoi chois ag Meiriceá i gCuan Guantanamo agus tá an t-ádh dearg orainn go mbeidh a leithid linn ag an Scoil Gheimhridh. Beidh oíche spraoimhar cheoil ar son na Palaistíne an oíche sin chun airgead a bhailiú do mhuintir Gaza - bígí linn.

Named after the radical Irish-speaking socialist-republican Máirtín Ó Cadhain, we are delighted to share the programme for Scoil Gheimhridh 2024. For the second year running has been organised to provide a democratic and inclusive platform and space for activists across a wide range of community campaigns that contribute to our collective fight for a new Ireland which embodies the watchwords ‘Liberty, Equality and Solidarity.’ The conversation around a United Ireland is undoubtedly gathering momentum. Broad sections of society are already engaged in the debate around the constitutional future of Ireland and we must ensure that the voices of those on the margins are heard and help shape the new Ireland we want to see. We are delighted that Clare Daly MEP, Bríd Smith TD and Chris Hazzard MP will join us for the main panel on Saturday 27th January discussing ‘Building a New Ireland but for what Class?’ as well as the winter school’s guest speaker, Mansoor Adayfi in conversation with Clare Daly. Mansoor suffered 14 years of detention and torture without ever being charged in the US military prison Guantanamo Bay - we are lucky to have him with us at the winter school! We will finish off with a concert for Palestine to raise funds for Gaza - bígí linn.

CLOSE GUANTANAMO BAY - MANSOOR ADAYFI IN CONVERSATION WITH CLARE DALY

Rugadh sa Yemen é Mansoor Adayfi agus nuair a bhí sé 18 bliain d'aois, cuireadh i gCuan Guantanomo, príosún mileata de chuid SAM. B'íospartach céastóireachta é Mansoor agus cuireadh faoi chois é ansin ar feadh 14 bliain gan chórasamh. Tá leabhar scríofa aige faoi *Don't Forget Us Here: Lost and Found at Guantanamo* agus déanann sé stocaireacht chun an Cuan a dhruidim.

Mansoor Adayfi was born in Yemen and at 18 years of age he was detained in Guantanamo Bay, the infamous US military prison. Mansoor was tortured during the 14 years he spent there without ever being charged. He published a book *Don't Forget Us Here: Lost and Found at Guantanamo* and he now campaigns to close Guantamno Bay down.
