



"Bhí Baile Uí Mhurchú go hiomlán imeallaithe agus fágtha ar lár mar cheantar. Bhí fadhbanna sóisialta ollmhóra aici agus rinne an chomhairle agus an stát neamhaird ar fad uirthi. Ag an phointe seo d'oibrigh mé féin agus Séamus Mac Seáin ar Bhaile Uí Mhurchú. Bhí muid go hiomlán dirithe ar an cheantar. "Ballymurphy was totally marginalised and excluded as an area. It had massive social problems and was completely neglected by the council and the state. At this point myself and Séamus Mac Seáin were working on Ballymurphy. We were completely focused on it. The only way we could help these people was to bring back some of their self-respect and show them that they could rebuild the place themselves."

FOCAL BROLLAIGH

Anois ar theacht na laethanta fada, oícheanta níos teo agus ceapacha corcra ar an Sliabh Dubh, tá a fhios againn go bhfuil an t-am sin den bhliain buailte linn: Féile na gCloigíni Gorma 2024. Tá an fhéile phobail uathúil san Uachtar Chluanaí ag bailíu nirt diaidh ar ndiaidh gach bliain leis na heochairfhocail Pobal, Dlúthpháirtíocht agus Folláine lárnach ann.

Bláthaíonn leor mór Cloigíni Gorma fiáine atá dúchasach de Pháirc Tua an tSléibhe Dhuiibh achan Bhealtaine. Baineann muid úsáid as na cloigíni gorma mar shiombail le cur i gcuimhne do dhaoine faoi aoibhneas an tsaoil, a ndúrla nádúrtha agus an tábhacht a bhaineann le sláinte agus dlúthpháirtíocht phobail.

Chonaic muid réimse d'fhorbairtí san fhéile anuraidh. In ómós do lucht eagraithe de chuid an chéad fhéile sa cheantar in 1973, d'eagraigh coiste Fhéile na gCloigíni Gorma mórshíúil dhathúil leis na céadta duine ag siúl síos Bóthar na Carraige Báine mar chlabhsúr na féile. Dúirt eagraí pobail áitiúil ó Theach Chnoc an Fhoinse, Ciarán Cahill, gur fhág an Fhéile in 1973 an

lóchrann ag glúin Fhéile na gCloigíni Gorma. Leanaimid misneach na gceannairí áitiúla agus na fathaigh sin a tháinig romhainn a d'eagraigh tográí féincheduithe sa cheantar cosúil leis an fhéile in 1973.

Déanann Féile na gCloigíni Gorma 2024 cuimhne ar leith ar dhuine de na fathaigh phobail sin, Seán Mac Goill, atá imithe ar shlí na firinne le déanáí. Gael ceannródaíoch agus ceannaire pobail a bhí lárnach i neart tográí clochlaitheacha ón bhun aníos sa cheantar bainte le comharchumannachas, athghiniúint phobail agus athshlánu na Gaeilge, ní bheidh a leithéid ann arís. Suaimhneas síoraí ort a Sheáin.

Is é seo an 8ú mblían den fhéile a bhunaigh gníomhaithe áitiúla san Uachtar Chluanaí agus na ceantair máguaird in 2017 mar fhreagairt ar thréimhse gharbh na déine a d'fhág daoine sa cheantar in ísle brí, leis an sprioc chun muintir na háite a athnascadh leis an timpeallacht galánta thart orainn, i measc bealaí eile chun dlúthpháirtíocht a léiriú leis an phobal.

Sna 8 lá den fhéile, beidh imeachtaí ar siúl do theaghlaigh agus do dhaoine de gach aois a bhfuil suim acu sa timpeallacht, an Ghaeilge, spórt, an tsláinte mheabhrach, stair, acláiocht, ealaín, ceol, polaitíocht, cainteanna, scannánaiocht, drámaíocht agus go leor eile!

Tá muid an-sásta go seolfaidh an t-Ardmhéara Ryan Murphy an fhéile i nGael-Ionad Mhic Goill ar an 10ú Bealtaine agus beidh mórshíúl na féile ann arís i mblíana ar an 11ú sa cheantar le cur in iúl don chathair go bhfuil Féile na gCloigíni Gorma 2024 faoi lán seol!



Cuireann an fhéile béim ar athnascadh leis an timeallacht ghalánta thart orainn agus an tábhacht leis an tsláinte mheabhrach a chur chun cinn. Chuige sin, beidh snámh breacadh an lae ag Cuan Helen, taiscealaíocht ar an sliabh leis an Rewilding the Black Mountain Project, ceardlanna i nGairdín an Phobail, siúlóidí agus rití phobail, concair dhúrla na bpáistí, agus go leor eile.

Tá áthas orainn go mbeidh ár gcomrádaithe san fheachtas spreagúil Script Úr don tSláinte Mheabhrach ag óstáil síceoláil mór le rá Lucy Johnstone mar chuid den fhéile. Beidh ainmneacha móra le rá eile againn le linn na féile ach go háirithe iarbhairisteoir Bhaile Átha Cliath CLG Séamus Ó Gábháin a bhain 6 Chraobh Uile-Éireann idir 2012 agus 2019; chomh maith le haoi cáiliúil eile, David Keohan, a bheas ag tabhairt ceardlanna ar sheanraidiúsún na hÉireann, tógáil chloiche, agus an géarghá chun an traidisiún seo a athghhabháil.

Is ceisteanna díchoilíniithe iad seo ar fad agus tá an Ghaeilge ag croílár na féile chomh maith. Tá lúcháir orainn go mbeidh seoladh leabhair le hEoghan 'Gino' Mac Cormaic, turas treoraithe ar an Sliabh Dubh trí Ghaeilge, lá spraoi le Leanaí Loch Lao, camchuaireart reilige le Seán Fennell, lá teaghlaigh de chuid an togra Suí 's Scíth, ceardlanna ar stair na Gaeilge agus go leor eile chun athshlánú na Gaeilge a chur chun cinn!

Chun crích a chuir leis an fhéile, seinmneoidh cuid de na ceoltóirí áitiúla is fearr sa chlub sóisialta The West ar Bhóthar na bhFál ar an Satharn 18ú Bealtaine. Thar ceann an choiste stiúrtha, ba mhaith linn fáilte mhór a chur roimh chách a bheith linn chun brí phobail, dlúthpháirtíochta, ceiliúrtha agus folláine a chothú agus a cheiliúradh!

FOREWORD

Now with the approach of longer days, warmer nights and purple stretches across the Black Mountain, we know it is that time of the year again: Féile na gCloigíni Gorma - The Bluebell Festival 2024. This unique community festival in the Upper Springfield is growing year after year under the watchwords of Community, Solidarity, and Wellbeing.

Each May the famous Black Mountain 'Hatchet Field' blooms and chimes with the glorious site of a sea of indigenous wild 'Bluebells' (Cloigíni Gorma). We use the symbol of the blooming 'Bluebells' to remind local people of the joys of life, their natural environment and our historical and spiritual connections with our environment and community.

We saw a range of developments in the festival last year. In homage to the organisers of the first festival in the area in 1973, the Féile na gCloigíni Gorma committee organised a colourful parade with hundreds of people walking down the Whiterock Road to conclude a wonderful 2023 festival. Local community organiser from Springhill Community House, Ciarán Cahill, said that the 1973 festival had passed the torch - which was the symbol of hope during that festival - on to the Féile

na gCloigíni Gorma organisers. We continue to be inspired by the courage of those local leaders and visionaries who came before us and who organised self-help projects in the area like the festival in 1973.

This year's Féile na gCloigíni Gorma commemorates one of those community giants, Seán Mac Goill, who has sadly passed away recently. A pioneering Gael and community leader who was central to many community regeneration and grassroots projects in the area involving co-operatives, Irish language revival and more, we will never see his likes again. Suaimheas síoraí ort a Sheáin.

This is the 8th year of the festival which was founded by local activists in the Upper Springfield and the surrounding areas in 2017 as a response to the harsh times of austerity and increased poverty that left people in low spirits, with the aim of reconnecting the local community with the beautiful environment around us, among other ways of showing solidarity with the community. In the 8 days of the festival, there will be events for families and people of all ages who have an interest in the environment, Irish language, sports, mental health, history, exercise, art, music, politics, discussions, films, drama, and much more! We are delighted that the Mayor of Belfast Ryan Murphy will launch the festival in Gael-Ionad Mhic Goill on the 10th May, and the festival parade will be back again this year on the 11th May in the area to let the city know that Féile na gCloigíni Gorma 2024 is in full swing!

The festival emphasises reconnecting people with the beautiful environment around us and promoting the benefits of this connection for our mental health. To that end, there will be a range of outdoor activities from sunrise swims at Helen's Bay, exploring the mountain with the Re-Wilding



the Black Mountain Project, workshops in the local Gairdín an Phobail, community runs, sunset walks on the beach, children's nature trails, and many more.

We are thrilled that our comrades in the inspiring campaign 'A New Script for Mental Health' will host the renowned psychologist Lucy Johnstone as part of the festival for a workshop on 'creating more hopeful narratives about emotional distress'. We will have other big names during the festival, especially Dublin GAA manager Jim Gavin who won 6 All-Ireland Championships between 2012 and 2019; as well as other famous personalities like David Keohan, who will give a practical workshop on the old Irish tradition of stone lifting on the Black Mountain followed by a Q&A focussed on the urgent need to revive this tradition. These are all questions of decolonisation and the Irish language is at the heart of the festival as well. We are delighted to announce an Irish language book launch with Eoghan 'Gino' Mac Cormaic, a walking tour of Black Mountain in Irish, family

fundays with Laochra Loch Lao, a graveyard tour through Irish with Seán Fennell, a family day out with the Súi's Scith project, workshops on the history of the Irish language, and much more to promote the revival of our native tongue!

To conclude the festival, some of the best local musicians will play the Festival Concert in The West Sports and Social Club on Saturday 18th May. On behalf of the organising committee, we would like to welcome everyone to join us in building and celebrating a sense of community, solidarity, celebration and well-being!

Gino Mac Cormaic is a well-known language activist who worked as vice-president with the national Irish-language organization Glór na nGael. He published a comprehensive account of this period in his autobiography 'Pluid - Scéal na mBlocanna H' in 2022. He will be reading from his latest book 'Gaeil agus Géibheann - cími poblachtánacha agus an Ghaeilge'. The event is in Irish only.



Seo an chéad uair go mbeidh an turas seo ar fáil trí Ghaeilge ag eascairte ó pháirtíneireacht idir an lontaobhas Náisiúnta, Conradh na Gaeilge agus Fís an Phobail. ‘The Stone-lifting Tradition in Ireland’

Cosúil leis an Íoslainn, Albain agus Tír na mBascach, is seánraidiúsíonn na hÉireann é tógáil chloiche, a chaill mud le linn tréimhse fhíochmhar choilíneachas na Breataine san 18ú agus 19ú haois. Bhí na ‘cloch nírt’ seo mar dhlúthchuid de shocraí na tíre ar feadh na gciantsa. Le linn sochraídí, bainiseachas agus le ceiliúradh a dhéanamh ar na féilte ceilteacha.
